

Report on the Covid-19 Vaccination Drive, *In association with* University of Science and Technology, Meghalaya & ERD Foundation organized by the University of Science and Technology Alumni Association (USTAA), Meghalaya at different place of the State of Assam & Meghalaya 5th July, 2021 to 31st August, 2021 in association with the different Departments of USTM.

The year 2021 began with hope that the development, manufacture, and deployment of vaccines will soon bring the COVID-19 pandemic to an end. Halfway through the year, vaccination is underway across the world, albeit at a much slower pace for the mostly poorer nations. India is still far from reaching its own targets. The Government of Meghalaya and Assam is also ramping up the vaccination campaigns across the state.
